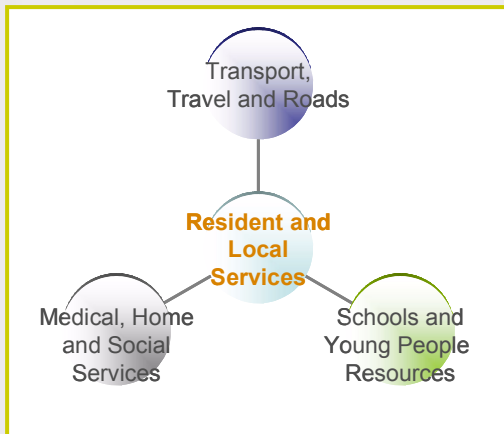




Manifesto for a better Quality of Life

Just some of the improvements ...

- Restore the Street Enforcement Officers
- Increase street cleaning, particularly in shopping areas and surrounding roads.
- Introduce 1 hour free parking in our town centres for residents
- Continue to increase recycling to include more plastics and biodegradables
- Increase the use of environmentally friendly Council vehicles in line with other Liberal Democrat councils
- Encourage the expansion of the weekly doorstep recycling service to all flats that want to be included.
- Install solar panels on Council owned buildings.
- Restore the weekday 'out of hours' service of the noise protection officers, now only operative at weekends.
- Restore the cuts to the library service hours and media fund. The £40,000 removed from the media fund this year can only mean fewer books in the libraries.
- Ensure the retention of wardens in sheltered housing accommodation.
- Spend more money on the youth services and work to ensure more affordable youth activities thus lessening disruption and anti-social behaviour by disaffected young people.
- Improve the children's play area in our parks.
- Continue to work closely with our local police community safety teams to prevent crime and anti-social behaviour in our area.
- Give £100 Council Tax discount to over 65's
