Court rules Barnet Parking Charges Illegal

Following our article in this month's Childs Hill News

your Liberal Democrat Councillors can now tell you that Barnet Council will not appeal the High Court's ruling that the increases in Residents Permit and Visitor Vouchers were unlawful.

We believe this is the right decision

Residents who made payments at the increased rates for their annual charges and/or for visitor vouchers will be refunded the difference in charge and should apply for a refund by filling out an e-

form on Barnet Council's website, barnet.gov.uk providing details of their name, telephone number, address, permit ID if they have it and car registration number.

Alternatively they can email the council at CPZParkingRefunds@barnet.gov.uk or write to; Parking Team, CPZ Parking Refunds, London Borough of Barnet, Building 4, North London Business Park, Oakleigh Road South, London N11 1NP

The Council aims to get the process completed in eight weeks but remember you have to apply for the refunds.

Your Councillors have constantly spoken out about the outrageous rise made by the Conservative administration in the CPZ parking charges which rose from £40 to £100 per annum and the rise in visitors charges from £1 to £4. We are glad to see the Court's decision and that refunds are being made. We hope the Council will now stop using Parking as a fund raiser and also see sense to revise the parking arrangements to allow 1/2 hour free parking in all the Barnet's High Streets.
